

# **ABCO ENGINEERING HYDRAULICS (HEREAFTER 'ABCO'):** **COMMERCIAL PIT JACK WARRANTY 'Terms & Conditions'**

## **THE ABCO GUARANTEE**

We guarantee our products to be free from defects due to faulty material or workmanship. The period of the standard 36 month guarantee commences from the date of delivery to the purchaser, either by us or by our distributor as specified.

### **36 MONTH STANDARD WARRANTY (Limited Parts)**

#### **FIRST 12 MONTHS – Full Parts Cover**

1. Any part failing from faulty materials or workmanship within the first 12 months from the date of purchase will be replaced/repaired free of charge. Accidental damage/misuse or damage due to a contaminated air supply i.e. water, of any component will not be covered by the warranty and will be treated as a chargeable repair.

#### **MONTH 13-36 – Limited Parts**

2. Any part failing from faulty materials or workmanship of our own manufacture between month 13 and 36 from the date of purchase will be replaced/repaired free of charge. Excluded from the above statement are consumable wearing parts i.e. cylinder seals, pump seals/o rings and air operation switches.

#### **36-60 MONTH EXTENDED WARRANTY (OPTIONAL) – Available in UK and Eire only.**

All 60 month warranties must be registered with Abco by completing the WARRANTY REGISTRATION FORM. This must be no later than three months after the delivery of your pit jack.

3. In order to qualify for the extended 36-60 month term of warranty, your Abco pit jack will require a chargeable full service at 36 months. This service is to be carried out by Abco or one of our authorised service agents. Abco will send a service reminder at 34 months. Abco do not carry out on site service, the pit jack must be returned to our factory at Southwell, Nottinghamshire, or to an authorised service agent. Unfortunately Abco cannot offer a loan pit jack while the service of your pit jack is carried out. After the 36 month service has been carried out your pit jack warranty will be extended for a further 24 months as paragraph (2)..

In order to ensure a long service life and continued warranty support on your pit jack, it must be kept in good working order and all operating parameters must be adhered to. E.g. water trap intact and drained, correct operating air pressure, keeping the jack clean etc. Details of maintenance are included in the operating manual. Failure to comply with the operating parameters and maintenance obligations may invalidate your warranty.

All claims should be notified to Abco by telephone, fax or email. We will then authorise the necessary repairs.

Abco or our agents are in no circumstances liable for any consequential loss or damage arising through any defect in our products.
